Step-by-Step Guide to Donate towards a Grant


Step 1: Visit <https://cfnrv.fcsuite.com/erp/donate/list/grant>. Be sure that you click on the "Grant Catalog" tab to access all available grant request. Read through the summaries of each request. Grant requests are grouped by area of interest (e.g. poverty, education, arts and culture). Each entry includes the organization name, a summary of the organization, the amount requested, and the amount that has already been funded by other donors. Select "Donate" on the grant you wish to donate to.

Step 6: This will bring you to your cart, which displays a summary of the grants to which you would like to contribute. Be sure that everything looks correct and the amounts are accurate. If you would like to update your recognition name, you can do so in the optional recognition box. Finally, please consider helping the CFNRV cover the credit card processing fees by choosing to add 3% next to "Increase Donation". Once you have filled out all appropriate information, select the Review tab.





Step 8: A box will pop up asking for your name and address. Fill that out and click Payment Info.




Step 9: Enter your credit card information and hit pay
